History of BA 701 and the French Air and Space Force Academy Biography Général Pineau



BIOGRAPHY OF GÉNÉRAL PINEAU

Born on 1 February 1922, General Jean-Marc Pineau was admitted to the Air Force Academy at the age of 20 as part of the 1942 intake, known as the 'Commandant Tricaud' class. He died on 21 January 1971 on the snow-covered slopes of the Ardèche, where the Nord 262 in which he was travelling crashed, along with several senior officers and key officials from the Atomic Energy Commission. General Pineau had logged over 4,800 flying hours. A Commander of the Legion of Honour, holder of the TOE War Cross, recipient of five commendations, the Aeronautics Medal and the Escapees' Medal among others, he was an officer of great distinction and high culture, destined for the highest ranks of the Air Force. Air Base 701 is proud to bear the name of General Pineau, a pilot and commander of unshakeable faith who loved his profession passionately and served the Air Force and France with a sense of duty and exceptional conviction.

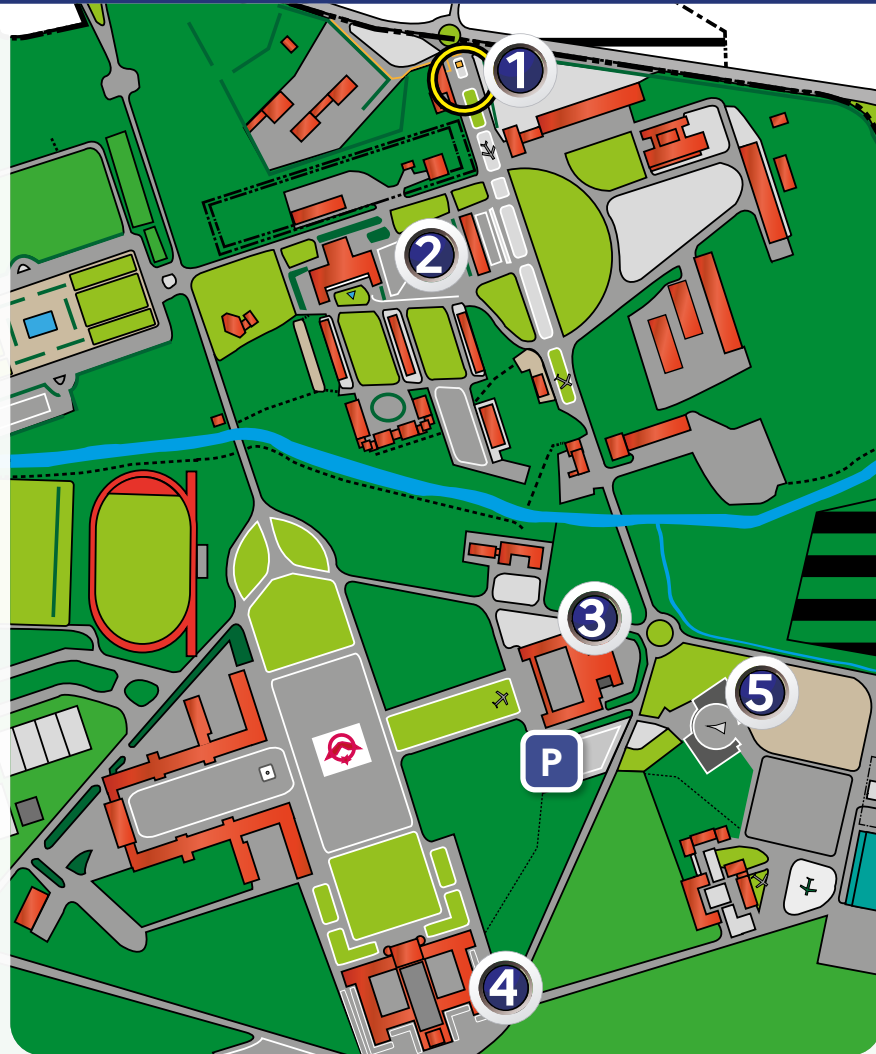

Each guest is issued with a personal card, programmed according to their membership category. To ensure a smooth service, it is important that your account is topped up sufficiently before you go to the till, preferably by debit or credit card.

If your card is lost, a replacement will be charged at €5. Pricing at the cadet mess and the mixed mess: €3.10 for 25 points. How is the cost of your meal calculated?
